SACRAMENTS

Baptism

Baptism is celebrated after consultation with the parish staff as to date. Registered membership in the parish and attendance at a Baptism Class are required for all parents prior to their first child's Baptism.

Holy Communion

A two-year required sacramental preparation process begins in the first grade. It culminates in the celebration of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion in the second grade.

Confirmation

A two-year required sacramental preparation process begins in the sixth/seventh grade. It culminates in the celebration of Confirmation.

Matrimony

A six-month required sacramental preparation process begins when the engaged couple meets with the priest or deacon and culminates in the couple's exchange of consent on their wedding day.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

A one-year process for preparation and study is required for all those interested in becoming Catholic.

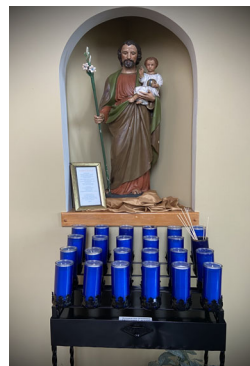

CHAPTER SEVEN: GATHERING AREA: PART 2 (continued)

SHRINES:



To the left of the etched windows is another Crucifix. This one is in a Hispanic style from the Philippines and was added in 2015. On either side of the "Apostle Doors" are shrines to Mary and Joseph. These statues go back to the 1893 parish church.



Near the double doors leading to St. Mary's Hall there is a shrine to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, a symbol of Divine Love expressed in the human actions of Jesus. ***(This has since been moved into the sanctuary, to the back south end corner)***

At some of these shrines there are votive candles. These are lit to represent that someone is praying for a special prayer intention. In a way it is an invitation for us to pray with them, as they ask the Lord and the saints to agree with them in prayer.

CHAPTER EIGHT: BLESSED SACRAMENTAL CHAPEL

Think private devotion and adoration.



Inside St. Andrew Catholic Church is a very special treasure called the Eucharistic Chapel.

The first thing you encounter as you move toward it through the gathering area are the steel gates. These depict the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy (Buddy Fister's handiwork). Receiving Communion should inspire us to lay down our lives in the service of others.

The Spiritual works of mercy are depicted on the south gate. (1) Praying for the Living and the Dead: incense pot, (2) Forgiving Injuries: the nailed hand of Jesus, (3) Instructing the Ignorant: the tablets of the law, (4) Correcting the Sinner: the compass, (5) Counseling the Doubtful: the lighthouse, (6) Comforting the Sorrowful: outstretched hand, and (7) Bear Wrong Patiently: Jerusalem cross

The Corporal Works of Mercy are represented on the North Gate; (1) Feeding the Hungry: the place setting, (2) Giving Drink to the Thirsty:

the water pitcher, (3) Clothing the Naked: clothes, (5) Visiting the Imprisoned: cell bars and padlock, (6) Visiting the Sick: bed, and (7) Burying the Dead: grave maker.

These are interspersed with wheat, grapes and chalices to show they are expressions of a Eucharistic Life.

These also serve a practical purpose. They are locked over night to keep someone from going through

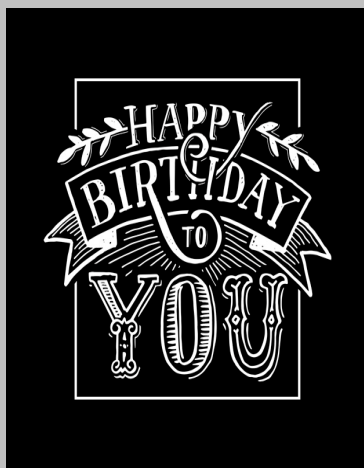


